Basic Function

The Licensed Mechanic, when issued a Company Authorization (ACA), is authorized to perform Certificates of Release to Service or maintenance releases on equipment for which he or she is qualified.

The Licensed Mechanic performs duties assigned by the Shift Supervisor or Director of Maintenance and may supervise, assist, and oversee the work carried out by unlicensed mechanics and trainees under on-the-job training (OJT).

Duties and Responsibilities

The Licensed Mechanic performs tasks generally recognized as work on or about aircraft and component parts, including inspection, testing, maintenance, repair, and certification of completed work in accordance with company standards.

Specific responsibilities include:

- Perform overhaul, maintenance, and repair of airframes, powerplants, avionics, aircraft communication equipment, and associated components in accordance with Company Manuals and SMCAA regulations.
- Inspect and test aircraft systems and components, signing for work performed when authorized.
- Ensure all work is performed in accordance with approved data and company procedures.
- Supervise unlicensed Assistant Mechanics and sign OJT records where applicable.
- Identify defective work, failed parts, or unsafe conditions and take corrective action independently.
- Ensure technical manuals and documentation are current and properly used.
- Assist the Shift Supervisor in assessing daily workload and maintenance planning.
- Initiate and complete required documentation for repairs and inspections.
- Ensure removed parts are properly tagged with complete discrepancy descriptions.
- Maintain clean and organized work areas.
- Report faulty or inoperative equipment to the Shift Supervisor.
- Maintain personal tool kit and ensure proper inventory control of company tools.
- Adhere to company guidelines and Company Rules during duty hours.
- Perform additional duties as assigned by the Shift Supervisor or Director of Maintenance.

Qualifications

The Licensed Mechanic must have:

- Completed an approved course in Aircraft Maintenance Engineering **or**
- Completed a minimum two-year apprenticeship at an approved maintenance organization.

The candidate must demonstrate the skills, knowledge, and experience necessary to hold a valid National Aviation Mechanic License and must have successfully passed the Air Regulations examination of the Netherlands Antilles prior to issuance of a Company Authorization (ACA) by the Quality Assurance Manager.

Required Certifications & Skills:

- Valid SMCAA Airframe, Powerplant, and/or Avionics Certificate (A, B, or C ratings).
 - Positive attitude toward productivity and quality maintenance standards.
 - Thorough knowledge of the General Maintenance Manual relevant to assigned responsibilities.
 - Knowledge of Maintenance Schedules, Work Order procedures, and proper completion of required documentation.
 - Strong English written and verbal communication skills.
